Dear Friends of the Sweet Onion Christian Learning Center,

I hope that this letter finds you well and that this fall has started off in the direction that you had hoped! Here at the Christian Learning Center we are excited that this school year has gotten underway and that everything has found its way back into a routine.

Each year near the beginning of the semester we like to do something that helps us know where our students are, but also to create a small tool for believers who really want to "know" where the students in our community stand with their relationship with Christ as well as their general knowledge of Him. This year we were able to survey many students from VHS, and the results are in. While we know that no survey is 100% accurate unless you survey every single person in the population, we were able to survey well over the statistically reliable threshold to trust the results. While data does not explain causes for change, the fact that there is significant change should cause all in our community who care about the Kingdom Work of Christ to stop and pause to ask, "why?" and "what can I do?". We hope you will find the information useful in your attempts to reach students in our area.

Why did we do this to begin with you might ask? It only takes mere seconds to Google "stats" concerning youth and Christianity from a nationwide perspective, but our students aren't nation wide... You can easily find stats concerning the "bible belt," but our students are only in a certain part of that belt... With a little effort and time you may even find some stats referencing South Georgia students... BUT where are you going to find statistics about Vidalia, GA and our area school students? It's easy to think, "Well, the world is going away from Jesus," and miss the reality of what is going on in "our little world" across the street. This data shows a progression downward over the past 5-6 years in regards to a typical "Christian" worldview and practice.

Attached you will find a document with the highlighted results of the surveys. Please feel free to email me or call or even Facebook message with questions about the results. I hope that this will be a tool you can use to reach students, that pastors and youth pastors can use to grow their youth ministry, and MOST IMPORTANTLY I hope that the results we found can be used to light a fire in your congregations and families to do even more to REACH students in our area for Christ, to make disciples that follow hard after Jesus!!
